

Instructions > Stealth Radio Harness



INSTRUCTIONS

- · Unbuckle the side release buckle.
- Place left arm through arm hole, and your head through the top hole created by the webbing.
- Bring webbing strap around your back, and snap the buckle on the side to secure harness.
- There are four adjustment buckles. Two on the shoulders, and two on the lower straps. For the best fit, be sure to make the harness snug around your torso.
- Unlock the radio pouch buckle to allow the radio to slide into place.
- To secure radio, stretch the bungee cord over the top of the radio, and snap the buckle closed.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Inspect Harness for any damage. If webbing is frayed or cut, discontinue use. Over time elastic may lose strength and therefor not keep radio secure.

Cleaning

Clean Radio Harness with warm water and mild soap to remove dirt and grime. Over cleaning may cause materials to wear over time. Harness should always be dried thoroughly before storing.
